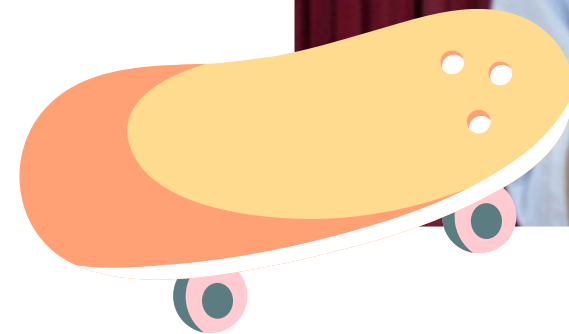
The school celebrated Earth Day

The Chess & Carrom Competition



The Thumb and Palm Painting Activity

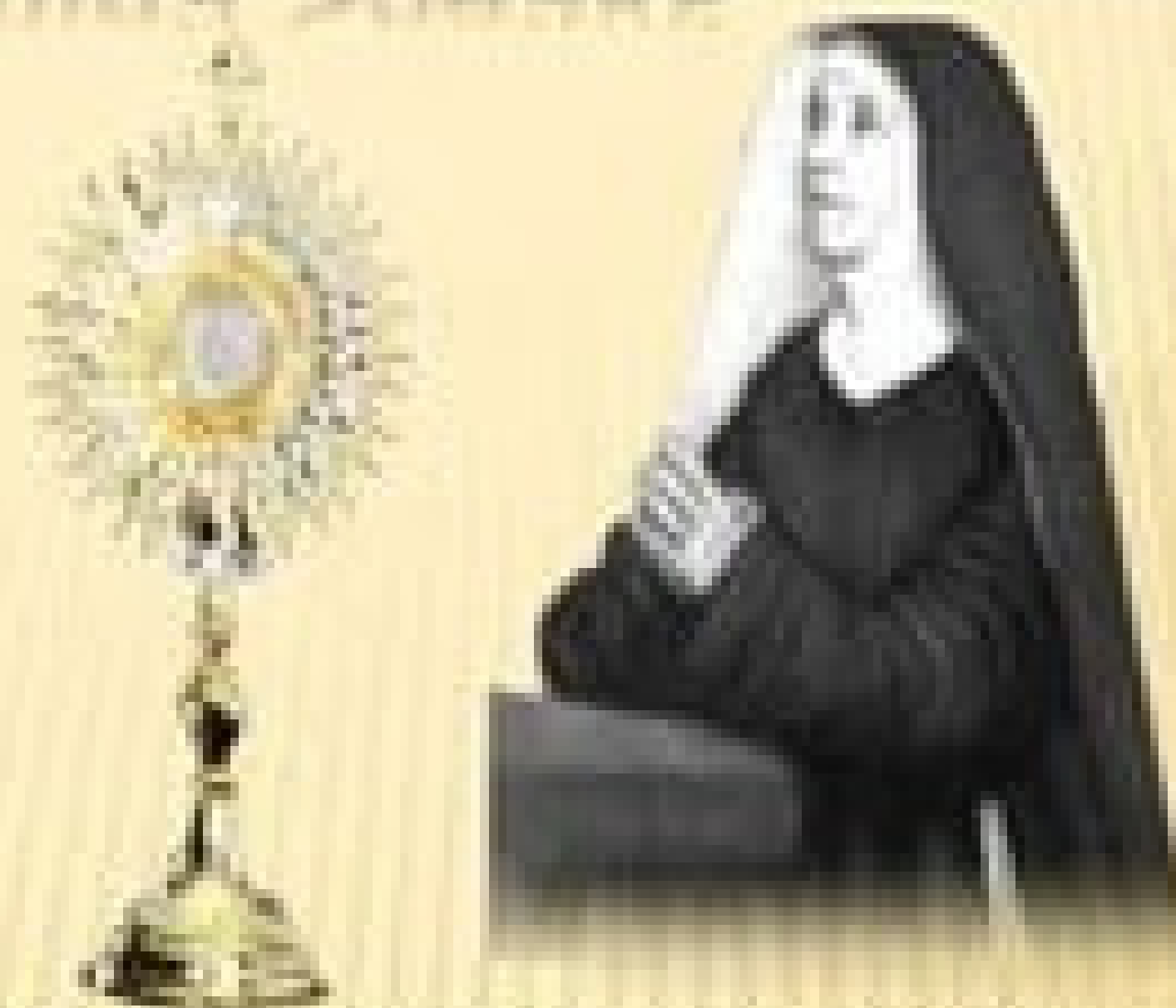
